Adoration *for our* Nation

Thank you for your help in organizing a Day of Adoration at your parish on election day, November 3. We've put together these simple steps needed to encourage your fellow parishioners to join Catholics across the country in prayer.

1. Ask your Pastor—you will need to have your Pastor's approval and support
 - In this time of national uncertainty and unrest, there is a nationwide movement to open Catholic churches on election day for Eucharistic Adoration, to bring hope, healing and peace and ask for God's blessings for our country.
 - You would like your parish to participate.
 - You have the materials to help organize this, including bulletin announcements, flyers and sign-up sheets.
 - You are willing to be available on November 3 throughout the day to ensure everything runs smoothly.
2. Working with your Pastor, determine the adoration time frame. We suggest immediately following the morning Mass until the polls close in your area, but any time frame is valuable.
3. Register your parish on the UniteOurNation.net website, [here \(link\)](#), we'd like to keep track of how many parishes are doing this across the country.
4. Contact fellow parishioners to ask them to sign up for a time (usually an hour commitment), and also ask them to help spread the word. There should be two confirmed adorers signed up for each hour. For efficiency, one email to all the parishioners you know should be sufficient.
5. Have your parish put the announcement in the bulletin, on the website and also include in email communications to parishioners. Include your name and contact information so parishioners can sign up. Sample announcements are on the UniteOurNation.net Resource page.
6. If you have a parish school, contact the principal and ask them to consider bringing classes of students over to adoration throughout the day.
7. Download the promotional flyer from the Resource page, customize the dark blue area, and print out to hang up in your parish. You can also email it to the parish office and ask them to put it in the bulletin as an insert. Remember to put your contact information on the flyer.
8. Send emails on Nov. 2 to everyone who signed up for an hour to remind them of their time.
9. Assist your Pastor as needed to help the day run smoothly.

That's it! You've just done a beautiful thing for your parish, community, state and country.
